- Financing International Trade (Methods of Payment in International Trade, Cash-in-Advance, Letters of Credit, Documentary Collections, Open Account, Export Working Capital Financing, Government-Guaranteed Export Working Capital Programs, Export Credit Insurance, Export Factoring, Forfaiting, Government Assisted Foreign Buyer Financing);
